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CODEBOOK FOR 2014 SURVEY OF HOUSEHOLD ECONOMICS AND DECISIONMAKING  
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The codebook serves as the principal guide to the variables included on the public version of the 2014 Survey of Household Economics and Decisionmaking (SHED) data set.

The SHED is sponsored by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System. Data for the 2014 SHED were collected by GfK using their online probability based KnowledgePanel. Some variables are removed in creation of the public use dataset in order to protect the confidentiality of respondents. This public version of the data is provided for research purposes only, and may not be used to attempt to identify any individual respondents.
