Your comment: As a small community bank in rural Nebraska, we are asking and urging the Federal Reserve Bank to take a lead in providing a solution for real time payments. We feel strongly that the payment system needs to stay in the same format as today with payments and settlements taking place directly in FDIC insured financial institutions.
