I have had to contact the attorney general to prevent one of these from becoming so serious, it jeopardizes my children's future. Even though these were errors of ignorance, tell me which of you has not overlooked a payment, or had their identity stolen. I mean those of you who actually pay your own bills and don't subcontract the job. My son is worried about keeping his job and surviving with the crappy health care he has, he doesn't need to be prey to every vulture who is in the credit card business.
