Noncompliance with TILA requirements is a common legal problem in DOT lending, and often a grounds of invalidation permitting other means of saving a home. There is no reason to change long-standing substantive and procedural law of TILA rescission in the midst of the foreclosure crisis and before comprehensive examination of the legal aspects of the crisis.
