About 25 percent of my customers use plastic, and the monthly fee that I pay to allow this to happen is sickeningly high. The percentage has increased to 1.98 percent per sale. Why should they continue to get raises when I don't?

It is right to regulate this industry because they are out of control. The urgency is even greater because the times are tough and so many small businesses are just barely hanging on. Please do not make any changes to your ruling. I will look forward to it becoming law in June.
