Hello, Federal Reserve,

I am not in favor of changes to the way checks are processed in the United States of America.

Even though I don't write as many checks as I once did, I have found that many businesses are charging 2%-3% or more to accept a credit card payment. For example, just this month, 2 Doctors' offices (a Neurologist and a Cardiologist), and a car dealer for service on my car, informed me that a credit or debit card would cost an extra fee, and they encouraged me to "pay by check or cash". I do not carry that much cash, ever. And, substantial amounts of cash (like a vehicle service) are not typically available from an ATM.

In addition, my primary bank, where my checking account is based) is a Military - based bank ( USAA), and physical bank locations are limited, and none are in my State of Tennessee.

Please reconsider a decision to eliminate paper checks.
