Bitcoin isn't going anywhere. The real question is whether it gets regulated properly or gets pushed offshore where no one can see it.

Blanket restrictions don't protect anyone. They just move activity away from U.S. oversight into places with zero AML controls. That's the opposite of what regulators should want.

Treat Bitcoin like any other financial product. Assess the actual risk, regulate accordingly, and go after the bad actors. Don't punish the whole industry because some people misuse it.
