
CODEBOOK FOR 2024 SURVEY OF HOUSEHOLD ECONOMICS AND DECISIONMAKING

The codebook serves as the principal guide to the variables included on the public version of the 2024 Survey of Household Economics and Decisionmaking (SHED) data set. However, not every variable included in the survey is included in the public use data set. For example, the data set does not include most variables related to details of geography or free-text responses.

The SHED is sponsored by the Board of Governors of the Federal Reserve System. Data for the 2024 SHED were collected by Ipsos using their online probability based KnowledgePanel.

ANALYSIS WEIGHTS

Weights play a critical role in interpreting the survey data and allow the sample population to match the U.S. population based on observable characteristics. The public use dataset contains two sets of weights, and users should consider the appropriate weights for their analysis.

The first set of weights ("weight" and "weight_pop") should be used when analyzing single year cross-sections of data for all respondents. The second set of weights ("panel_weight" and "panel_weight_pop") should be used when analyzing respondents who took both the 2023 and 2024 survey.

The sample weight, "weight," is most commonly used and is the weight used for statistics published in the "Economic Well-being of U.S. Households in 2024." The population weight, "weight_pop," can be used for estimating population totals, as it sums to the total U.S. population from March 2024 Current Population Survey (CPS). Either weight will allow for the entire sample to reflect the observable characteristics of the U.S. adult population.

DEMOGRAPHIC PROFILE VARIABLES

In addition to the questions asked on the SHED, the data set includes demographic profile variables that were collected by Ipsos prior to respondents receiving the SHED. These demographic profile variables are typically labeled with the prefix "pp" in the data file with some exceptions and in the variable descriptions below. In some cases, such as the higher level of education, similar questions were asked in these demographic profile surveys and in the SHED. In these cases, the answers to the SHED questions were used for the "Economic Well-Being of U.S. Households in 2024" if they were available.
