TO: Federal Open Market Committee FROM: Arthur L. Broida CAS SUBJECT: Delegation of responsibility concerning appeals of denials of access to FOMC records

The Committee's Rules Regarding Availability of Information provide in Section 271.4(d) that "Any person who is denied access to records of the Committee (by the Secretary)...may file...a written request for review of such denial. The Committee, or such member or members as the Committee may designate...shall make a determination with respect to any such appeal within 20 working days of its receipt...."

At its meeting in January 1975 the Committee delegated responsibility for making determinations with respect to such appeals to Governor Holland, and in his absence, to Governor Coldwell. New action is, of course, required as a result of Mr. Holland's resignation from the Board and the Committee. At the meeting next Tuesday, Chairman Burns plans to recommend that the Committee delegate this responsibility to Governor Gardner, and in his absence, to Governor Coldwell.
