Shown below is a proposed schedule for FOMC meetings in 1986. The schedule attempts to make the intervals between meetings as equal as possible, subject to the constraints imposed by the Humphrey-Hawkins reporting dates and certain other constraints such as IMF meeting dates and the year-end holiday period. The pattern is generally similar to the one for this year, calling for Tuesday dates, with two-day meetings in February and July slated for Tuesday-Wednesday. The principal difference is that the October meeting is one week later in order to avoid a conflict with IMF meetings, and the two subsequent meetings are also later than the corresponding meetings in 1985.
