



COMPACT DEVELOPMENT RESONATES




54% of all adults surveyed chose three or more compact development attributes.

BABY BOOMERS (48-66)

Most likely to...


- Want to live in a smaller home and have a shorter commute

Most likely to...

- Stay in their current homes
- Want to live in walkable neighborhoods
- Want to be close to health services, friends and family, shopping and entertainment
- Live alone




